

**Two Art History Positions:** The Department of Art and Art History at the University of Texas at San Antonio invites applications for two tenure-track positions. Position (1) is at the Assistant Professor rank with a specialty in either Pre-Columbian Art History or Modern/Contemporary Latino/Latin-American Art. Position (2) is open rank, with a specialty in Latin American Viceregal/Colonial art history and visual culture. Interdisciplinary perspectives for both positions are especially welcome. We encourage scholars from traditional art historical approaches to visual culture and studies of new media. The candidate for position (1) should have some teaching experience beyond the T.A. level, and a record of serious research; publications are a plus. ABD's will be considered with a degree completion of May 2009. For Associate/Full rank for Position (2), the candidate should have substantial teaching experience, a publication record and an excellent scholarly reputation. In addition, the successful candidate must demonstrate the ability to work in an integrated studio/art history environment, and will be required to teach courses at all levels in his/her area, from lower division surveys to graduate seminars, and classes made up of students in both the Art History and Studio Art programs. The teaching load is commonly 3-2, but there is room for negotiation at the senior level depending on levels of research.

We welcome candidates with diverse cultural, ethnic and national perspectives for this position. All applications will be acknowledged and reviewed in the order they are received. Application Deadline is January 24, 2008. Applicants must submit: 1) a letter of application, 2) a current rĒsumĒ, 3) examples of recent publications, if applicable, 4) the names, postal and email addresses, and telephone numbers of three references, 5) a self-addressed, stamped envelope for return of materials.
